The opening of "Duh Angel Live @ Jenny's" was also a book launch and a performance. People took turns standing on small white pedestals in front of microphones and reading from New York artists R. Lyon and Jessie Stead's *Duh Angel*, a volume made up of their prolific texts to one another. A live feed of the readers played on a screen behind them.
